When will we open again?

Parish Council agreed to work towards recommencing services at the start of July. However, government-mandated regulations require us to:

- Have two 'welcomers' (sides persons) to greet people, ensure that they sign a register, sanitise their hands, and do not join if they are not well.
- Sanitise books and pews.
- Separate entrance and exit.
- Have 4 m² per person.
- Not serve refreshments after 9.30am services.

Consequently, we need to know: Are those on the roster to facilitate services willing to participate, (sides persons, readers, lay assistants) and will parishioners attend services?
