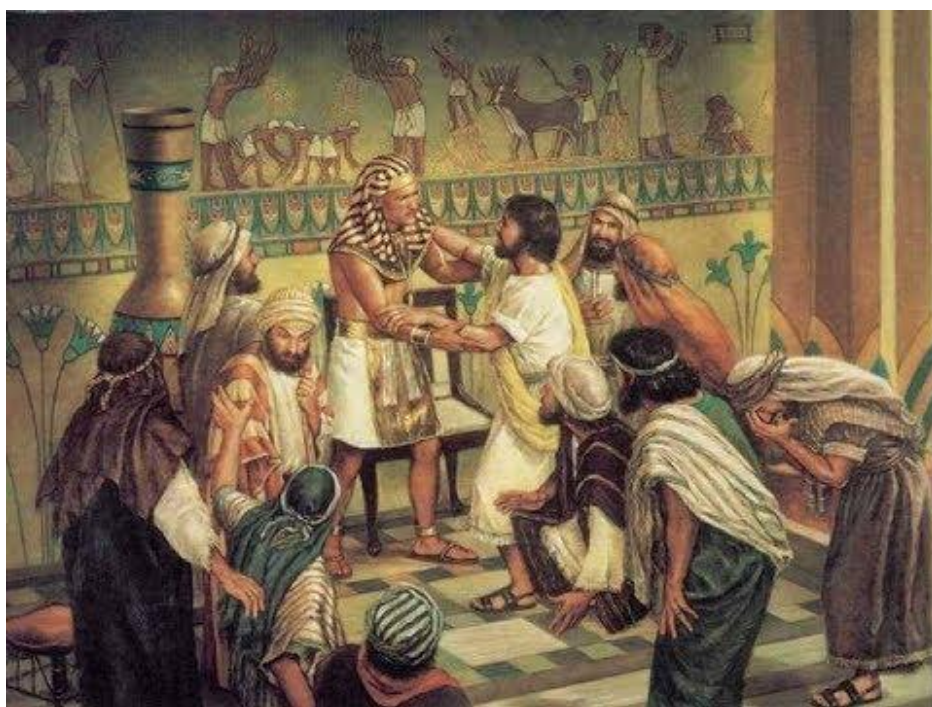

We will consider the updated Parish Vision statement; and examine the results of the NCLS and what they may mean for our community.

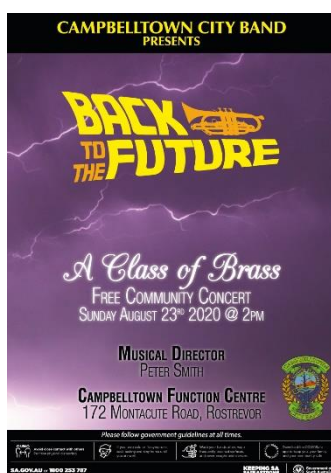
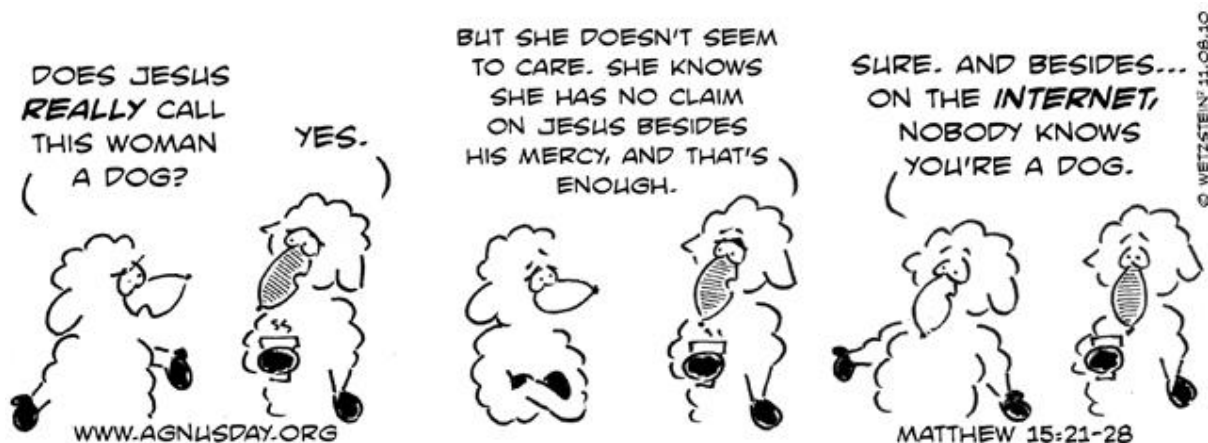
