



Notes from Vestry

Thank you to those who asked for more details about the Hall renovation and the church restoration. Parish Council (PC), as your elected leadership, is pursuing action in both these areas. An outline of the latest information follows. Minutes of PC meetings and financial information is in the folder at the back of the church, so always available for consultation.

Hall Renovation

As required by the Diocese, 3 were quotes sought for construction work, 7 for the flooring because it is a valuable Jarrah floor and quality of finish is important for dancing groups' use. The project entails interior only due to cost: Replace ceiling tiles; repair and patch cracks, paint walls throughout hall, kitchen, toilets, internal entrance area; paint ceilings in toilets, kitchen and entrance; replace cracked glass in emergency door.

PC selected **Adelaide Property Renovations (APR)**, Paul Edwards, who renovated and now lives in the home next door, recommended by Nat'l Trust.

Estimated cost: \$28 000 with unknowns like repainting badminton lines, moving and storing or covering furniture and fittings.

PC budget allocation: \$40 000

Time Frame: April 6-23 over the Easter holidays, but may not be completed due to building boom's making sub-contractors difficult to engage.

Note: Working bee to clean and repaint exterior entrance area will be organised by Nish DM. **More questions:** Ask Julia

Church stabilisation

There are different expert opinions on how to stabilise the church building, which must be done before we can attend to repairing cracks and re-plastering and painting. PC therefore consulted "stakeholders": Diocese; National Trust; and consulting engineer and architect who prepared original 2014 (updated 2019) Fabric Report. Engineer and architect agreed to prepare a project proposal with updated costing to install root barriers and moisture control measures, the preferred strategy to stabilise the soil around the building.

Note: In opinion of engineer regarded as a leader in this field in SA, vibrations from traffic on Stephen Terrace are **not** a significant problem.

As noted in the Wardens' Report to Vestry, the wild card is the roof, which needs to be replaced at some stage... **More questions:** Ask Julia or Sara
