## **Special Vestry Meeting 20 June, 10.45am**

Notice of a meeting to consider and vote on a proposal to use funds from the Parish Endowment Trust to finance the preparatory investigations (based on the 2014/2019 Swanbury Penglase report)

and works to stabilise the church building and make it safe. The quoted cost of "design, documenting and administering the contract for works..." is \$13 574. The cost of the work itself: "Installation of root barriers and underground irrigation system around the perimeter walls of the Church building"; is as yet unknown.

#### Motion:

Parish Council recommends that:

"Vestry agrees to using up to \$100 000 of the moneys held by the All Souls' Anglican Church Endowment Trust for work needed to stabilise the church building."

## Eligible to vote (Parochial ordinance)

Individuals must be:

- A member of The Anglican Church of Australia,
- A communicant of the said Church,
- Belong to no other religious denomination,
- Have received Holy Communion not less than 3 times during the past 12 months (June '20 – June '21),
- Be older than 16,
- Be a member of the parish of All Souls, St Peters.
