## Note from the Treasurer at the half-way point of 2021

The table below is very encouraging as it shows the continuing financial support for All Souls' Parish through Pledged and Open Plate Giving. The giving in the first half of each year has increased in the past two years after a dip in 2019. This is especially significant considering the current time of uncertainty.

The Parish leadership is especially thankful that Parishioners clearly remain both spiritually and materially faithful as this provides encouragement for forward planning. The cost of maintaining three buildings and employing a fulltime rector increases each year. We are grateful when your giving reflects that you understand these increased costs. Our only other sources of income are donations and hall rental. The unpredictability of hall closures during the pandemic has created even greater unreliability of income.

Current and past Parishioners and their families have also generous donated to the National Trust Appeal and to the Parish. The National Trust Appeal received **\$11,000** during the past couple of months and a further **\$3,800** was given directly to the Parish. We are sincerely grateful for this generosity. – Sue Crees
