Notice of a meeting to consider and vote on proposals related to pews.

Motions:

Parish Council requests that Vestry approve the following motions:

1. "We seek retrospective approval from the Diocese for the removal of pews from the Lady Chapel in 2000 and from the rear of the church in 1995 and the subsequent sale of some of those pews".
2. "Currently, the remaining pews that were removed are stored in various places and we request permission to sell some of these to raise funds for the on-going maintenance of the church building."

DISCUSSION ONLY

To unscrew and move alternate rows of pews from the church to be replaced by chairs spaced so that we are compliant with COVID-19 distancing regulations.

Eligible to vote (Parochial ordinance)

Individuals must be:

- A member of The Anglican Church of Australia,
- A communicant of the said Church,
- Belong to no other religious denomination,
- Have received Holy Communion not less than 3 times during the past 12 months (August '20 – August '21),
- Be older than 16,
- Be a member of the parish of All Souls, St Peters.

Please make every effort to be present, 15 people are required for a *quorum*.
