

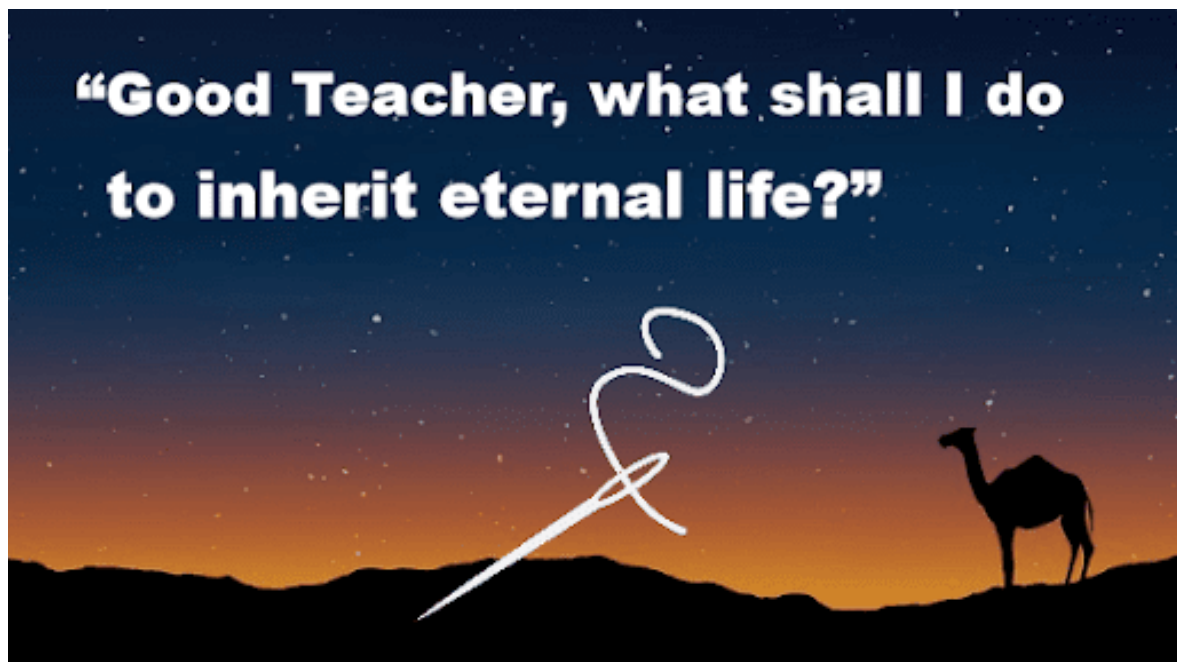

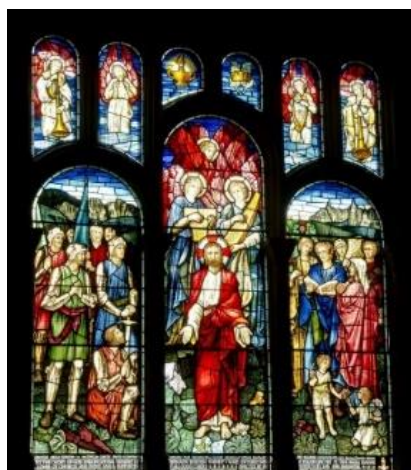

**From the Archbishop's Pastoral Letter to clergy, 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2021**

### **Preparations for an easing of Covid-19 Restrictions**

Announcements from State Governments, especially NSW, indicate that Covid-19 restrictions are likely to ease from the middle of this month. At this stage the South Australian government has made no announcements other than a commitment to the national plan. It is also expected, as has been the situation overseas, that with the general easing of restrictions and opening of state borders will come an increase in Covid-19 infections. This means that clergy may at short notice not be able to lead services as planned and we may not be able to source other clergy to take over. I recommend that planning take place so that services of morning prayer or prayer praise and proclamation are prepared for use by lay people at short notice. If churches don't have lay people who are accustomed to leading worship, it may also be a good idea to train a number who can step in.

### **Covid 19 vaccinations**

I am continuing to encourage everyone who can be vaccinated to get vaccinated and as soon as possible. I hope the clergy of the Diocese are receiving vaccinations and encouraging people to do the same. Getting vaccinated is part of being a good neighbour and is focussed on the welfare of the community.

### **Bell Ringing for COP26**
