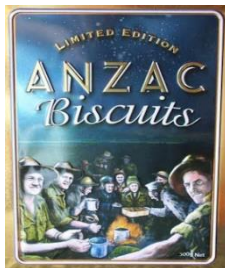

Directions:

- Continue approx. 2.5km, (crossing railway line). Street name changes to Cricklewood Road
- Turn left into Devonshire Road
- 2nd property on right – white-fenced gate entrance 5 acres to find your own quiet space. It is not a parkland or display garden but has easy access cleared areas, and hilly bushland for more seclusion.
