Giving can be arranged through your bank as a recurring payment or by making regular one-off transactions. Bank details are on the 2022 Form.

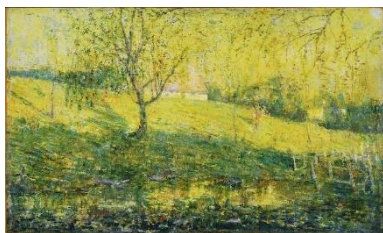
Open Plate
