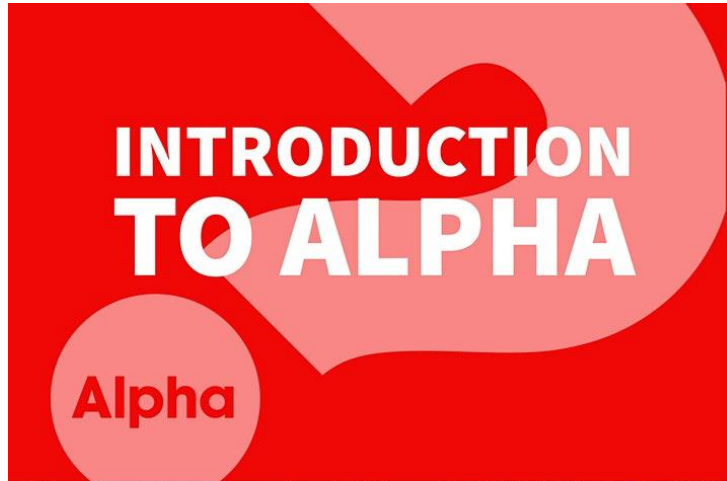
Theme: *God's Church for God's World*
