News from Parish Council (PC) 20/9/22

- Please turn out for a **GARDENING WORKING PARTY** on Saturday 8 October at 9.00am at the church. Bring gardening equipment and wear suitable clothing. Speak to Pauline for more information.
- Diocesan Council has approved the parish proposal to carry out the **STABILISATION** measures costing \$320 000, subject to confirmation of a loan from AFSA (Anglican Funds South Australia). More detail to follow...
- The PC will seek listing of the church as a **STATE HERITAGE** listed building, which is expected to take up to 18 months due to a backlog of applications and changes to the relevant legislation
- The **PATRONAL FESTIVAL** on 6 November at 9.00am will celebrate almost 140 years since the parish was proclaimed in 1883. It will focus on *All Souls through the Ages* with displays of *memorabilia* like documents, records, photographs, banners, vestments and baptism and wedding clothing and photographs. - PC plans to have a **SILENT AUCTION** coinciding with the Patronal Festival to raise funds for the restoration of the church. If you have items to donate for auction please speak to Emma or Julia e.g. a hamper of artisan foods; a weekend in your beach cottage; a dinner for two; an artwork or a spa voucher.
