



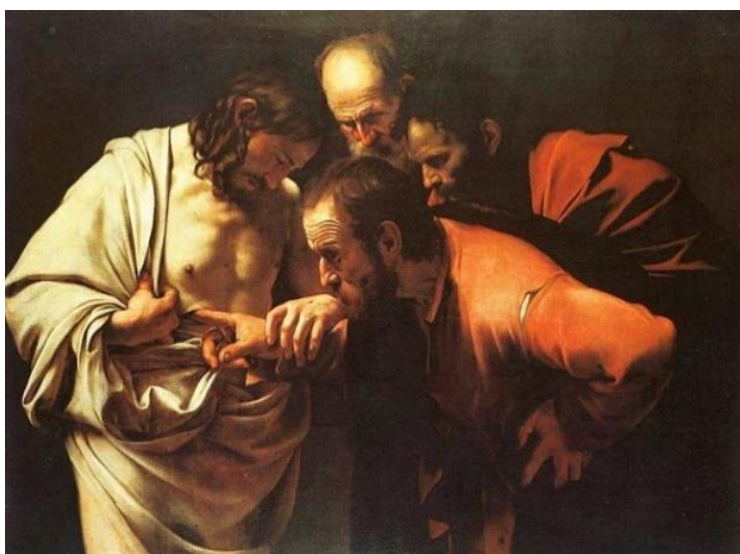

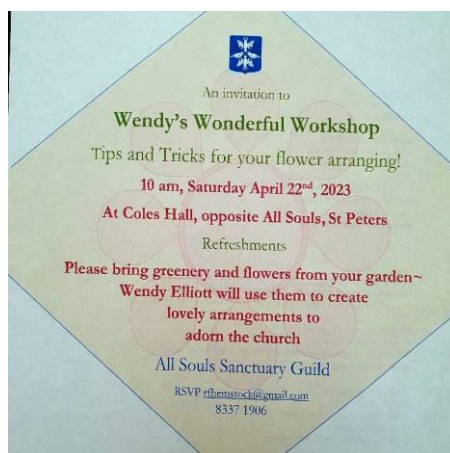

IMPORTANT

SPECIAL VESTRY MEETING to VOTE on the SALE of an ASSET

10.00am Sunday 30th April in Kay Hall

After a combined worship service at 9.00am

In order to vote, Diocesan regulations require assent to the following:

I DO HEREBY DECLARE that I am a member of The Anglican Church of Australia, that I am a communicant of the said Church, that I belong to no other religious denomination, that I have received the Holy Communion not less than three times during the past twelve months, that I have attained the age of 16 years, and that I am a member of the parish of All Souls, St Peters.

Special Vestry Motion 1:

That Vestry agrees:

1. To sell the Rectory at 51 Fourth Avenue, St Peters.
2. To find accommodation for our Priest with the help of the Diocesan Property Officer, using some of the funds generated.
3. To use the balance of funds to stabilise the church building.
4. To recognise that the sale of further assets may be required in future to fund repairs to the roof and brickwork; and build toilets on the west side of the church.

OR

Special Vestry Motion 2:

That Vestry agrees:

1. To instruct the Directors of the Parish Endowment Trust to use Trust funds to secure a bridging loan to:
 - a. design and build toilets west of the Church building;
 - b. demolish Coles Hall and retain building consultants to design and build a new Rectory on the site;

and then:

1. To sell the Rectory at 51 Fourth Avenue, St Peters to repay the loan.
2. To use the balance of funds to stabilise and repair the church building.

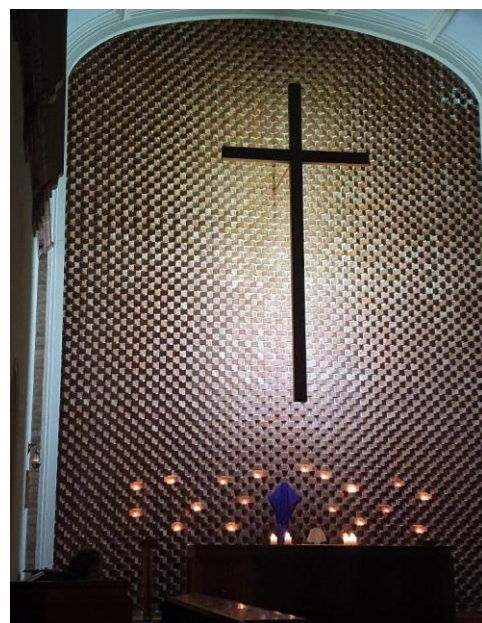
