#### All Souls / St Theodore's Conversations and 2024 Opportunities

Parish leadership has reported previously that we have commenced conversations with St Theodore's, Toorak Gardens about opportunities for collaboration and partnership. Here is an update on progress.

Above all else, both parishes have agreed to the core principle that both will remain independent in governance, finance, synod representation and parish life. There is no interest in merging or combining to become a joint ministry.

Rather, we are exploring ways to collaborate, in areas where it makes sense so to do. To this end, a working party meets regularly, consisting of the wardens, priests, and one parish representative from each parish, chaired independently by the Archdeacon, the Ven Andrew Mintern. Both Parish Councils have met at All Souls for a meal and will hold another next year.

We also plan to bring a report to both Vestry meetings (25th February 2024) of progress to date.

For 2024, we have planned a number of joint activities and will also advertise events to both congregations. Some of these include:

- 1. Two or three joint Lenten studies, Monday 7pm @ All Souls and Sunday 11:30am @ St Theodore's; hopefully one online.
- 2. Shrove Tuesday Pancakes @ All Souls (10am, 13th February)
- 3. Ash Wednesday services (14th February) 10am @ All Souls (with transport arranged) and 6pm @ St Theodore's.

#### 4. Holy Week:

Stations of the Cross service (26th March) @ St Theodore's *Tenebrae* (27th March) @ All Souls.

- 5. Ways to share administrative work are being investigated.


# Who locks the church or clears the sand trays?
