A Christmas Message from David...

In his book *The Secret of Staying in Love*, John Powell wrote, 'Love is not a feeling, Love is a decision'. This simple, but profound phrase goes to the heart of true love. If you are married, if you are in any meaningful kind of relationship, practice these words in your life and you will not be sorry: Love is not a feeling, love is a decision. Feelings are wonderful; we usually have plenty of them buzzing around inside of us when we fall in love and that is how it should be. But feelings alone will not sustain us for the long haul of love, because true love demands commitment, perseverance, sacrifice; it needs to hang in when the other goofs up. Feelings alone will never win another back because they can often get hurt, but a decision will. And true repentance is always a response to wounded, decisive love, it can never earn love; it can just receive it in humble gratitude.

God so loved this world that he didn't just get all mushy and throw an in-house party for the angels, hoping that the feeling would at least last for a few short light years. God loved this world so much that he made an incredibly risky and vulnerable decision. God sent his only Son in the form of a fragile baby, born in a lowly stable near a pub in Bethlehem with a no-vacancy sign; born to an insignificant young woman, Mary and her betrothed husband, Joseph, who wasn't even the biological father. Now that's a pretty shaky way to make a divine decision, I'm sure you'll agree.

In the womb of Mary, decisive love was implanted. Love which would heal, forgive, restore, transform, disciple, millions of people. Innocent love yet crucified for us and our salvation. Love made Flesh: Jesus, the Christ. So, I suggest this to you: The Word of God made a fragile decision in Love for you and me. Christmas invites each one of us to make a decision in love about the Word of God and the force that Jesus has to transform our lives into a Living Sacrifice of Love. The real Christmas calls each of us to decide to do something very creative with our lives which will make a vital difference to this world, racked by war, violence, and innocent suffering. It can make a vital difference to our own lifestyles. We could begin by spreading some peace and forgiveness around. Peace on earth begins with a decision – your decision, my decision, the decision of nations – in love for this world.

Christ was born for this.
