

THE NATIONAL COMPREHENSIVE ANGLICAN NETWORK.

Bishop Stephen Pickard, a good friend of David's is the Chair of the new NCAN that was mooted a long time ago to be a voice for Anglicans who were very happy to stay as they were, and in distinction from The "Southern Cross" or GAFCON parishes and members. It has taken a long time for the NCAN to get off the ground, but at last, here it is. Here, in part, and edited, is what Bishop Pickard has written about it:-

"Dear All,

Welcome to the National Comprehensive Anglican Network (NCAN). The good news is at last we're up and running! Our mailing list includes people from all over Australia. We plan to send out a newsletter on a regular basis to keep people up to date, provide useful resources and links and enable people to remain in conversation.

NCAN does not intend to set itself up over against other entities, movements, organisations or trends and trajectories in the Church. It is not just another player on the ecclesial field. NCAN exists to help the Anglican Church of Australia understand itself better as part of the One Holy Catholic and Apostolic Church of Jesus Christ.

We offer a forum for a continuing conversation and open dialogue in the Church about the things that matter that belong to the Gospel of God and that concern us as Christians. We join with all who long to be faithful disciples of Jesus Christ, to uphold and promote the unity of the Church and to bear witness to the Gospel. We are made up of Anglicans who desire to promote the unity of the church and its witness to the Gospel. In 2026 we hope to hold a national conference. Further details of this will be announced in the near future.

I commend NCAN to all who share our hopes and dreams for a closer and deeper understanding of what it means to be one-in-Christ.
