

## DAWN SERVICE AT BEACONSFIELD Tasmania 2006

The first time since the war, while it was still dark On the ninth day of May, the church bells rang out To tell the townsfolk their two miners were free Scooped from their tomb in the bowels of the earth

Buried there on Anzac Day while others marched One more was crushed to death just metres away They stayed there for a fortnight that felt like a year We slept, worked and played; it was business as usual

The media gathered from all corners of the globe The locals were good, they embraced them as friends Frances, a woman of the cloth, rallied the troops Got the prayers flowing and the casseroles going

From these dear souls, drinks were also forthcoming To drown some sorrows and steady some nerves Frances said few eyebrows were raised in her clan Even teetotalers understood and were proud

And then they were out! The whole town turned up A helmeted Guard of Honour was the order of the day They looked so well for the ordeal they had suffered Loved ones just hugged these men in joyful disbelief

Two ambulances stood by for their trip to Launceston A check up in Hospital to make sure they were fine A hearse was there too on that bittersweet day It was like Good Friday and Easter rolled into one

Above all, I hope the event will provide the opportunity for the whole Diocese to come together in a spirit of encouragement as we look to build on Archbishop Geoff's legacy for a vibrant future.

#### From Emma


