**Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May** The Rev'd Russell Simmonds will celebrate both 8am and 9.30am services.

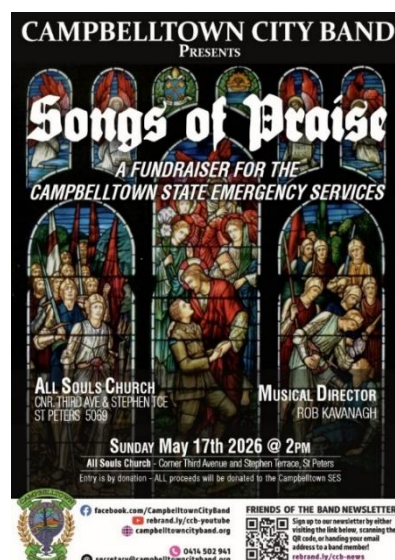
**Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May** Cambelltown City Band Concert 2pm
