FROM THE ARCHIVES

As we congratulate our award recipients, it was interesting to read an article that appeared in the Parish Magazine in July 1917. The father of a soldier contemplated the possibility of his son being awarded the VC for his actions in wartime. He believed that having the following “VCs” would be just as valuable to soldiers (and us) as being awarded the medal:

- Be Very Courageous – Trusting in God’s might
- Very Cheery – Believing God is always with you
- Very Courteous – In humility before God as everyone is your brother
- Very Constant – In prayer to God
- Very Content – Knowing God does all things well
- Very Clear – As to your being led by King Jesus
- Very Careful – In all you think, and say, and do
- Very Considerate – To weaker comrades and help them all you can.
A cup of water given in Jesus’ name never goes unrewarded.
- Very Chary – As to the wiles of the wicked one and his confederates.
He that is for you (Jesus) is greater than all that can be against you.
