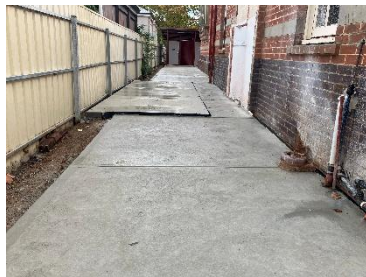
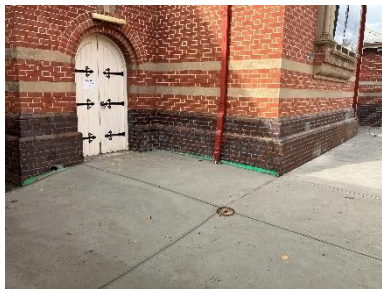


If you didn't attend the Campbelltown Brass Band concert on Sunday 17<sup>th</sup> May you missed a real treat.
