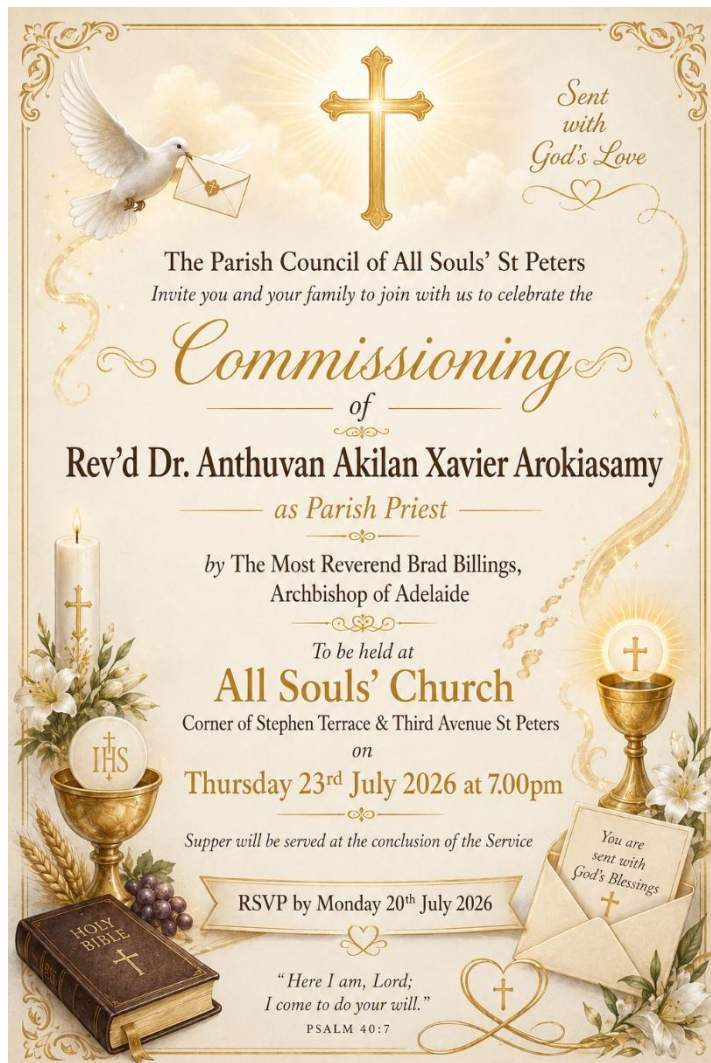

MORE PARISH HERITAGE



As well as the Morris windows and the carved wooden candle holders mentioned in the last newsletter, the Parish owns beautifully embroidered altar frontals and pulpit hangings that are often overlooked because they are "always there".

In this season of Ordinary Sundays, it is worth looking more closely at the detail on the green velvet fabrics that adorn the pulpit and the high altar. Green symbolizes hope, life and spiritual growth.



Although their age is difficult to identify, the hangings have been displayed and stored for many years and were in danger of becoming too fragile for use. We are grateful for the professional talents of Mary Jose from *Fabric of Life* who has made repairs and advised the best way to conserve our Parish heritage. Mary restored the Sunday School Banner in 2024.

During the Commissioning service on 23rd July, the cloths will be white. White is used for celebrations, including Christmas and Easter.

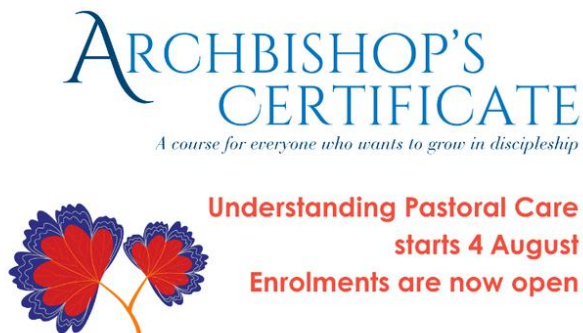
SUNDAY BEST @ ST OSWALDS

Understanding Pastoral Care:
a tender care that transforms lives
led by Rev'd Dr Gethzi Devasagayam,
Tuesdays, 9.30am - 11am, 4, 11, 18 & 25 August
at St Luke's Church, Whitmore Square

This module introduces pastoral care as essential for the holistic wellbeing of a person. It aims to prepare participants for providing a caring presence with competence and confidence. It covers basic biblical principles of pastoral care. It pays attention to skills pertinent to attentive listening and various possible pastoral responses. Participants will learn about the practice of pastoral care in differing contexts and cultures through the analysis of biblical and other texts and resources. Discussions based on case studies and role plays will aid this understanding. The module will prepare participants for the complexity of encountering difficult spiritual questions in the face of bitter experiences like trauma, death and bereavement.
