WENDT FAMILY REUNION



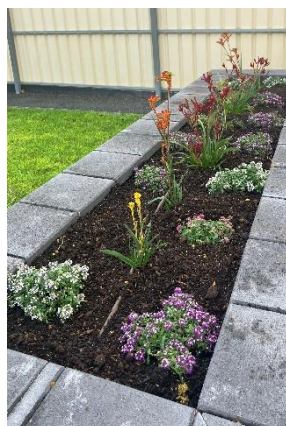
Tim, Otto and Michael Wendt

A NEW SHORT COURSE FROM ST BARNABAS COLLEGE

Enrolments are also open for a new short course from St Barnabas College on five Wednesday evenings during October and November at St Andrew's Anglican Church, Walkerville.

People completing the course will be equipped to offer Christian ministry with rainbow people and communities positively and effectively.
