ST FRANCIS OF ASSISI

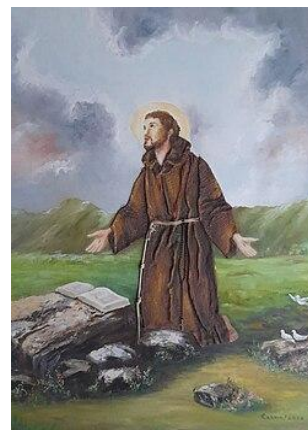
The 4th of October is the date when we remember St Francis of Assisi who died 800 years ago on 3rd October 1226. St Francis founded the Franciscan religious orders of Friars Minor, the women's Order of St Clare (the Poor Clares) and the lay Third Order.

St Francis considered all nature as the mirror of God. He is believed to have preached to the birds and once persuaded a wolf to stop attacking the people of Gubbio and their life-stock if the townspeople agreed to feed the wolf. The wolf agreed and they lived together in peace.

PARISH HERITAGE



The first communion service was held in All Souls' Church on Ascension Day, 1st June 1916.

In his book *100 Years at All Souls' – 1883-1983*, Dean Rowney records:

"It was later learned that Donald Stewart Munro had been killed on the day the church was dedicated. His parents lived next to the church in Third Avenue and his father, Charles Munro, who "watched every brick go into place" served as a warden from 1919 to 1930. Donald's parents donated a solid silver chalice and paten in memory of their son."

Canon Murphy chose a chalice design based on a 16th century Elizabethan chalice in use in St Peter's Church, Oare, Kent for over 400 years. The chalice and paten were subsequently made by Wendt's Jewellers.

This chalice and paten will be used at the special service with Archbishop Billings on Sunday 4th October.



The inscription around the foot of the chalice reads:

*"In loving memory of Donald Stewart Munro
killed in action at Romani 1st June 1916
Requiescat in Pace
The gift of his parents
Charles Stewart and Catherine Munro"*

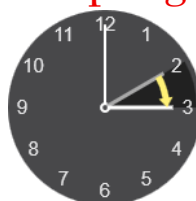
Amongst these items is a piano that, while in need of a lot of love, might be just what someone is looking for. It will unfortunately have to go to landfill if a new home can't be found.

A NEW SHORT COURSE FROM ST BARNABAS COLLEGE

Enrolments are also open for a new short course from St Barnabas College on five Wednesday evenings during October and November at St Andrew's Anglican Church, Walkerville.

Understanding and Connecting with Rainbow People and Communities is a short course about LGBTIQA+ people and communities in church and society: how we can connect to be genuinely inclusive, share wholeness of life in Christ, and recognise God's gifts in each other.

This course is open to all lay people, clergy and chaplains in parishes and other ministries. It will enable participants to develop a deeper and broader understanding of Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Intersex, Queer, Asexual/Aromantic people and communities and the intersectionality with other diverse ways of being human. People completing the course will be equipped to offer Christian ministry with rainbow people and communities positively and effectively.
